 - Antonio Matimber Monteiro


4. The procedure I followed was as follows:

I would be contacted by family member telling me someone they knew was in an accident or I would go to the hospital and find the injured person. I would then take the client to

the office. The client was never seen by an attorney *Z. J. NM*

from Norman Berger, nor by Anthony Miller or Mr Berger himself. They were seen by Thambi Vilekazi who was a filing clerk at Norman Berger.

5. I left Norman Berger's employment in 2009 after I became concerned as to how the fees were being charged by Norman Berger.
6. Clients would call me and complain. When I raised those complaints to Anthony Miller and Norman Berger they told me it was none of my business.
7. I was not prepared to be part of what I knew they were doing to the clients I touted for them and that is why I left their employment.

The following documentation is required for our records:

1. Copy of identity document or birth certificate.
2. If married, a copy of marriage certificate and antenuptial contract.
3. Residential and postal address as well as contact numbers.
4. If any property is owned, a copy of the Deed of Transfer.
5. If you have an existing Will, a copy thereof and information on where it is being kept.
6. Banking details for monthly maintenance.

The curatorship works as follows:

1. The Master of the High Court supervises the duties of the curator *bonis*.
2. The Master's approval must be obtained for all expenses and specific financial requests of the family.
3. We must be furnished with 3 quotations for any specific requests. These requests are then submitted to the Master and we have to wait for his approval or further requirements. This may take a while and therefore it is recommended that requests be submitted well in advance as we will not have an immediate answer.
4. Please note that a person under curatorship may not open any accounts (clothing, furniture, etc). We will therefore not take any responsibility for debt incurred after the appointment of the curator *bonis*.
5. An Administration Account is submitted once a year to the Master reflecting the capital and all income and expenses for that specific year.
6. The curator *bonis* receives fees as determined by the Administration of Estates Act and only once the Master has approved the Administration Account (and the fees).

I was involved in an accident on 24/08/2008 at 20h30 in Natalspruit. The accident took place next to my house. I was walking on the side of the road and it was dark at the time. An unidentified vehicle lost control and hit me. I was unconscious for about 2 weeks. 2 weeks later I woke up in Natalspruit Hospital. I had a fractured skull and other injuries.

I was in hospital for 2 months. I do not remember when I spoke to Jabu but it was when I was still in hospital.

While still in hospital my sister-in-law was visiting and Jabu approached me. It is not clear to me what we spoke about because I was still confused. I could not write or understand anything and know that I did not sign any documents. When I was discharged Jabu took me home.

Jabu used to return to my house to take me to at Natalspruit Hospital about twice a month after I left hospital. Jabu took me a few times to physiotherapy and at other times took a taxi.

During the time I was going to physiotherapy I did not go to the offices of Norman Berger at any stages.

I was never told how I was going to be charged for the work done by Norman Berger or how the claim worked at all.

In the beginning of my case the only time I heard from Norman Berger's offices was when a lady named Thembi used to call me and tell me about doctor's appointments. She then sent a guy named Mandla to fetch from my house and take me to Norman Bergers offices where I would then wait with others and then go in a group to the doctor's appointments. At Norman Bergers offices I never moved from the reception room or waiting room unless to use their toilet.

Some time later they called me to tell me that my court case would be on 29 July 2011. Before the court case I had a meeting with an advocate with who I think was called Norman Hill about 4 weeks before the court date at the offices of Norman Berger.

On the court date I went straight to court and was told to sit on the bench. The advocate I had met was not there. I met a Mr Miller and this was the first time I consulted with Mr Miller.

After some time another white gentleman came to me where I was sitting on the bench and showed me a printout of an offer which was R 1 200 000.00. He told me I will not get R1 200 0000 but he did not explain to me how much less I would get or why it would be less.


After court I was taken back to Norman Bergers offices. The receptionist said they will call me to make an appointment at a later stage. They gave me no documents. Don then took me back home.

After a few days the receptionist called me and told me to come back to their offices. Don fetched me. I met with a white lady and man who I had not met with before. In December I received a payment of R6000.00 and nothing else after that. As I need money I called the number on the business card which the white lady gave me. A copy of the business card is attached to this. I have tried to phone this number often as I really need money but no one ever answers.

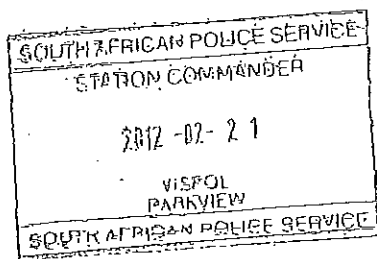



26. I received an amount of just over R 400 000.00(four hundred thousand rand) from Dube Attorneys.



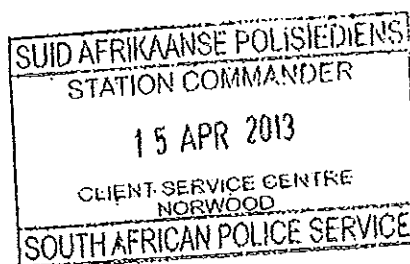



I was never asked by anybody from the Norman Berger and Partners Inc to pay any money upfront. I know my hospital bill was paid by my medical aid but the rest of the doctors appointments I don't know who paid them.

In June 2008 I received a letter from Norman Berger and Partners Inc dated 17 June 2008 stating that our claim is set down

for hearing in the High court Witwatersrand
local division on Tuesday 3rd February 2010.
as per annexure A.8.

In November 2009 I received another letter in the post dated 22 October 2009 for medical examinations for purposes of medico-legal reports as per Annexure A9.

In February 2010 I received a letter from Norman Berger and Partners Inc dated 24 January 2010. Stating that my instructions for my third party claim with the Royal Accident Fund were settled for ~~R4467-00~~ R4467-00 plus High Court costs as taxed or agreed. It also confirmed that they settled Charmaine's claim with the Royal Accident Fund R40467-00 plus High Court costs as taxed or agreed as per Annexure A10.

On Tuesday 23 March 2010 I went to Norman Berger and Partners Inc with my ID document as requested telephonically by the receptionist Cleo.

On my arrival at the offices of Norman Berger and Partners Inc I sat in the reception and Cleo the receptionist she was the only person I saw. She also handed

a cheque over to me for R47650-41 which I signed for in an affidavit form as per annexure All this does not indicate where I signed for the cheque.

On 30 March 2010 I was contacted by Cleo the receptionist of Norman Berger and Partners Inc telephonically and were told that I must come and collect the second cheque for my claim. I then told her that I will come on the 8th April 2010.

(19)

On 8th April 2010 I went to the Norman Berger and Partners Inc with a taxi and met Cleo in the reception. I asked Cleo why they give me two cheques and I also asked her about the amounts because I wasn't happy about the amounts. Cleo then phoned Mr Berger and told him that I wasn't happy about the cheques and the deductions. I couldn't hear Mr Berger's response on this matter. Cleo then just told me that the deductions was for the telephone bills and the transport and they still have to pay the doctors. I then received a cheque of R73275-00 from Cleo and then received a settlement letter

stating all the deductions and there was also an amendment regarding future medical treatment as per Annexure A12.

I then made a statement right there at the offices of Norman Berger and Partners Inc stating my unhappiness of how they handled the payments, as per Annexure A13. Cleo also stamped the statement with Norman Berger Stamp.

I never had a meeting with Mr Norman Berger or Mr Anthony Millar during this whole time. The only time I saw them was when I was introduced to them by Cleo when I went to see the doctor somewhere in 2008.

(22)

I was never informed by any member of Norman Berger and Partners Inc that there will be any deductions for traveling costs or telephone bills on my claim from the road accident fund.

(23)

In May 2011 I received a letter from Norman Berger and Partners Inc dated 23 April 2011 for medical examinations for my minor child Balde Beyonce

On the 6th December 2011 I went to the Norman Berger and Partners Inc offices and met with Bruce Malabi and he informed me about the trustfund and then introduced Mrs Geldenhuys to me as the Trustee. Mrs Geldenhuys told me that she is working with Norman Berger and Partners Inc. I then completed the forms regarding the bill for the attorneys and the settlement sum of R304 559-34 with taxation together with Mr. Geldenhuys as per annexure A16.

In January 2012 when Buhle Beyance Makhumela started school I were telephonically told by Mrs Geldenhuys that I have to fax the proof of the receipts of things bought for Buhle Beyance or if I want to request money for Buhle Beyance I must also fax a letter to her. I receive R34000.00 per month for food transport for Buhle.

In September 2012 I phoned Bernice the secretary of Mrs Geldenhuys and requested for a statement on the accounts. I was then told that they only issue statements after a year and up until today 19 April 2013 I haven't received any statement for that account.

Makhumela

I, Mariam Masala state under oath in English.

I am an adult female with ID Number 530312 0754 088 an currently residing at 11634 Thabana Street, Ext 7B, orange Farm, with cell phone number 071 110 9934.

On 29 November 2007 I was in a motor vehicle accident in Meadowlands, Soweto.

I was in an accident and Mvimo was a witness. The husband of Pinky, with cell phone number 082 632 8035, by the name of Joe – 078 359 7574 informed me about Norman Berger and Partners Incorporated.

I received a call from Norman Berger and Partners Incorporated and they informed me that they will be collecting me at Mvimo's house and to go to their offices at Norman Berger & Partners Incorporated to tell them the story of the accident.

In 20098 I was collected by a driver from Norman Berger & Partners Incorporated at Mviyo's house and went to Norman Berger & Partners Incorporated offices.

Myself and Mvuyo went into a boardroom where we found an African female and a white old male sitting at the table. The African female asked me if I want to make a statement regarding the accident. I then replied "yes".

The African female informed me that the injuries are serious and that I will be able to claim R 1000 000.00(one million rand). I told her that I am not worried about the money, but that I need help to be cured from all my injuries that occurred in the accident.

I handed over all medical documentation to the African female. The African female asked me questions regarding the medical documentation and many notes. Mvuyo was then asked questions regarding the accident and a statement was drafted.

I had pictures on my phone that was taken by my son, Kenneth Masala with cell phone number 076 451 2828 and handed them over to the African female that asked me if I have any evidence of eth accident. They extracted the pictures from my phone and then the African female took pictures of my head, arms and my body where I had visible injuries.

The African female then said we must go with the driver of Norman Berger & Partners Incorporated to the police station to sign a document that was not explained to me. Myself and Mvuyo arrived at the police station and the driver of Norman Berger & Partners Incorporated spoke to the police officer and I signed the documents. The police officer never explained to me what the document was that I signed.

The driver from Norman Berger & Partners Incorporated then took us home.

On several occasions I received letters from Norman Berger & Partners Incorporated informing me that I will be collected and taken to Norman Berger & Partners Incorporated offices, doctors and court by the driver of Norman Berger & Partners Incorporated. The letter received to be attached.

I was informed by the African female that no monies will have to be paid by me and that they will pay all the doctors and people involved. I was never informed that I will be paying for transport to


1. I am an adult female, with ID number 650510 0848 086. I am and currently unemployed and I reside at 1870 Senoane Soweto. My cell phone number is 076 800 6834.
2. I was involved in a motor accident on or about the 5th of May 2009. I was a passenger in a taxi travelling from Natal to Johannesburg.
3. I was badly injured in the collision and was transported first to the Hospital at Heidelberg, and thereafter to the Natspruit Hospital.
4. I remained under treatment at the Heidelberg Hospital for approximately one day and was thereafter transferred to the Natspruit Hospital where I remained under treatment for approximately one month and thereafter I was transported to the Sebokeng Hospital where I underwent an orthopaedic procedure on my hip.
5. While I was at the Natspruit Hospital I was approached in my ward by an African male known to me as Jabu who advised me that he could help me bring a claim in respect of the injuries suffered by me as a result of my accident as this was what he did. He mentioned to me that he was employed by Norman Berger and Partners Inc, a firm of attorneys in Johannesburg and that he wanted me to be a client of that firm of attorneys.
6. Jabu had no knowledge of either me or the accident that I was involved in but apparently was walking from ward to ward trying to sign up accident victims for this firm of attorneys Norman Berger and Partners Inc . After I had received the orthopaedic procedure at Sebokeng(my treatment lasted there about five days) I returned to Natspruit Hospital where Jabu once again visited me in a ward.
7. I remained at Natspruit Hospital on the second occasion; after being transported back to Natspruit Hospital for approximately three weeks. During that time Jabu communicated with me and took my telephone numbers and contact details.
8. After my discharge from the Natspruit Hospital I lived with my husband in Jeppe Street in the Johannesburg City Centre.

9. Approximately three weeks after I had moved in to my husband's apartment in the city centre, Jabu communicated with me telephonically and requested to learn whether he could collect me from my husband's flat to take to the offices of Norman Berger and Partners Inc.
10. Approximately a week after the telephone call I was collected from my husband's flat by Jabu and was driven by Jabu to the offices of Norman Berger and Partners Inc in Johannesburg.
11. At the offices of Norman Berger and Partners Inc a female employee, a non-European lady whose name I do not recall took a statement from me as to the circumstances of the accident. I recall signing the statement. I recall signing other documents at the first consultation but do not recall what the documents were. Jabu then gave me a lift back home.
12. I think the statement was taken from me round about September 2009 and I heard nothing from Norman Berger and Partners Inc and telephoned Jabu sometime during January 2010. Jabu then advised me that he no longer works at Norman Berger and Partners Inc. He was therefore not in a position to give me an update on what was happening with my claim. He did however give me the phone numbers of the firm Norman Berger and Partners Inc. to communicate with regard to my claim.
13. I telephoned Norman Berger and Partners Inc and spoke to people whose names I cannot recall who advised that they were not in possession of my phone numbers but that Jabu had my phone numbers and that they could not get hold of me that now needed to make appointments with various doctors to pursue my claim.
14. I do not recall the names of the drivers who collected me to take me to doctors but recall certainly that I visited at least four doctors at the Instance of Norman Berger and Partners Inc in their preparation for my trial herein.
15. I was advised by Norman Berger and Partners Inc that this matter would be proceeding to trial but it did not go to trial. I was taken by Norman Berger and Partners Inc for an interview at the Road Accident Fund where I was interviewed by an employee of the fund as to the extent of my injuries and I had to explain my injuries to the fund's employee.
16. The matter was then apparently settled and I was handed a cheque by Norman Berger and Partners Inc in an amount of R 57 148.88(fifty seven thousand, one hundred and forty eight cents and eighty eight cents) which I deposited into my account on or about the 22nd of August 2011. I annex here a statement of account received from Norman Berger and Partners Inc handed to me at the time that I received the said cheque.
17. That was the last of my dealings with Norman Berger and Partners Inc.

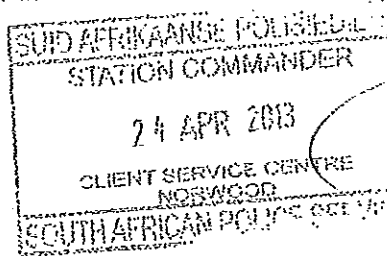
